## **WEEKLY UPDATE AND NOTIFICATION OF NEW CASES**

**January 16, 2021**

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility and notification that we received confirmation on January 14<sup>th</sup> that two residents tested positive for COVID-19, which brings our total number of cases since the onset of this pandemic to 11 residents and 30 staff members that have tested positive for COVID-19. We are pleased to report that all residents and staff that were affected are doing well. We are currently testing our residents and staff twice a week as required.

We are approved for virtual visits, window visits, outside and visiting booth visits. Some of our Resident may qualify to have family members be designated as Essential Caregivers for them. For more information about the function of Essential Caregivers and how to become one, please contact the facility.

As a reminder, Residents can receive packages through delivery services and they can be brought directly to the facility. Residents can also order take-out food and accept food from home that are prepared, stored and delivered according to facility safe handling practice guidelines. The guidelines are available upon request.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. As a reminder our residents can receive packages through the mail and they can be delivered to the facility. Please label items with the resident's name. They can also order take-out food to be delivered to the facility and can receive meals from home that are prepared, stored and delivered according to the facility safe handling guidelines. The safe handling guidelines are available upon request. Some of our residents will qualify to have essential caregivers. If you would like more information on becoming an essential caregiver please contact the facility.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering.
