



## **WEEKLY UPDATE**

**March 11, 2021**

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 22 residents and 32 staff members test positive for COVID-19. We are currently conducting COVID testing twice weekly. We have also completed 3 of 3 scheduled vaccination clinics for our residents and staff.

We are currently approved for virtual visits, window visits and outside visits. As a reminder, residents may have two essential caregivers of their choice assigned to them. Essential caregivers are family or friends the resident chooses that have attended an orientation for Essential caregivers, reviewed the facility's infection control policies and procedures regarding COVID and have tested negative for COVID-19. Please contact the facility to schedule a visit or to find out more about becoming an Essential Caregiver.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Please continue to check our website for weekly updates as well as notification of new cases. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.
